

Ouna Privacy Policy

Ouna Limited (“Ouna”, or “us”, “our”, “we”) respect the right to privacy of end users. Your ability to make informed choices about the use of your information is important to us. This privacy statement explains our policy regarding the collection, use, disclosure and protection of any information we receive.

NOTE: This privacy policy may change once Ouna begins offering services. Use of the services may be subject to a different privacy policy covering information collected by Ouna in the course of providing the services and how such information is used. Use of the services shall be subject to your agreement on any new privacy policy.

Information We Collect

The website may allow you to submit certain information, such as your name, address, email address, date of birth and proof of identity. The website may also allow you to create an account and choose a password. We will save all information and documents that you submit in the course of creating an account. The website may also automatically collect technical information concerning the devices and operating systems of visitors, such as your IP address and how you arrived at the Site. We may also collect information concerning your usage of the website, such as what pages you viewed and whether you followed any links on our site.

The website may also allow you to complete a personal assessment test. We save any information provided in the course of completing such assessment test as well as the results of such test.

How We Use Information

We may use information and documents that you receive to perform necessary anti-money laundering and “know-your client” checks. We will not share your personal information with third parties without your explicit permission, except when required by law, regulation, subpoena or court order or as otherwise expressly set forth herein.

Ouna’s current intention is to save all information that we receive until we have commenced offering services, at which time we will save all such information on a blockchain. Our current intention is that such information will be encrypted on a blockchain, such that the only entities to which you have provided authorization will be able to decrypt and access such information. Upon saving such information on a blockchain, we currently expect to delete all personal information of our users from our databases. Use of our services will be subject to payment of applicable fees.

While we expect to work diligently towards the foregoing goals, we cannot provide an exact timeline as to when all such goals may be achieved. In addition, technical obstacles may prevent us from achieving all or some of the foregoing goals.

By analyzing all information we receive, we may compile statistical information across a variety of users (“**Statistical Information**”). Statistical Information helps understand trends and customer needs so that new services can be considered and so the Services and associated services can be tailored to customer desires. We may use Statistical Information for our internal purposes, such as testing our products and improving our services.

How we Protect Information

We follow generally accepted industry standards to protect the personal information submitted to us, both during transmission and once we receive it. However, no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. Therefore, while we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children

We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under the age of 14. In the event you become aware that an individual under the age of 14 has enrolled without parental permission, please advise us immediately.

Other Uses or Transfer of Your Information

We will fully cooperate with any law enforcement authorities or court order requesting or directing us to disclose the identity or behavior of any user suspected to have engaged in illegal behavior.

We may use subcontractors that are located in countries other than your own, and send them information we receive. For example, we may send your information to countries outside the United States, Canada or the European Union. All our subcontractors will be subject to non-disclosure and non-use obligations. Nevertheless, some countries may have levels of protection of personal and other information which are not as high as in your country of residence or business.

We may disclose data as necessary for it to enforce its agreements and policies, to investigate any claims against us, and to protect ours and our agents', employees' and customers' rights and property.

We may transfer our databases containing information if we sell our business or part of it, or in the event of an insolvency, bankruptcy, or receivership in which information is transferred to one or more third parties as one of our business assets.
